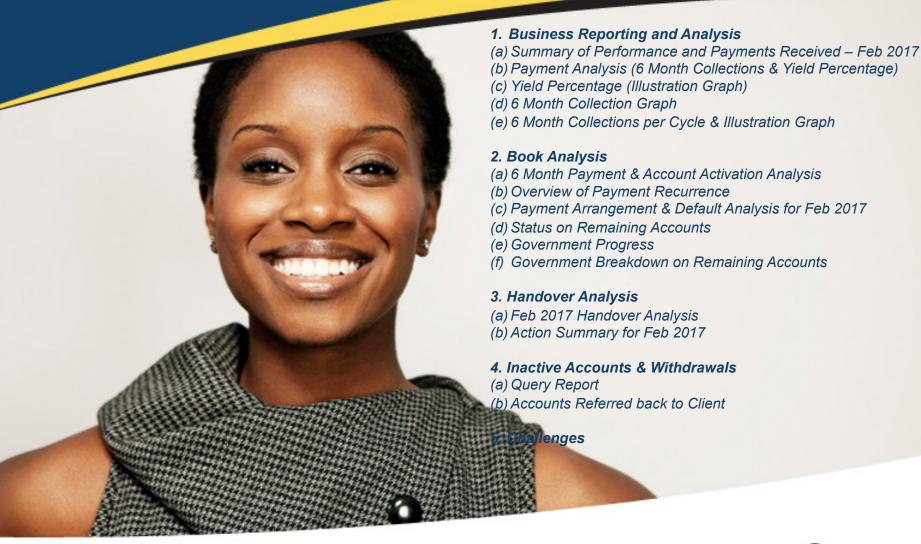

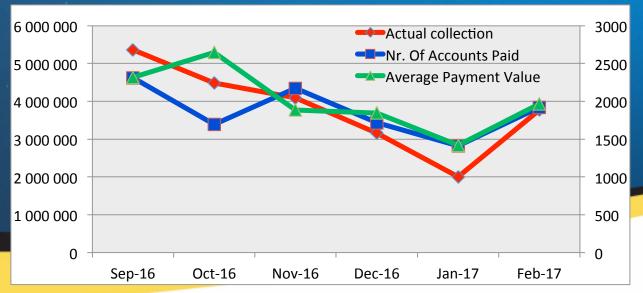

Percentage Yield achieved on Collections (Graph)



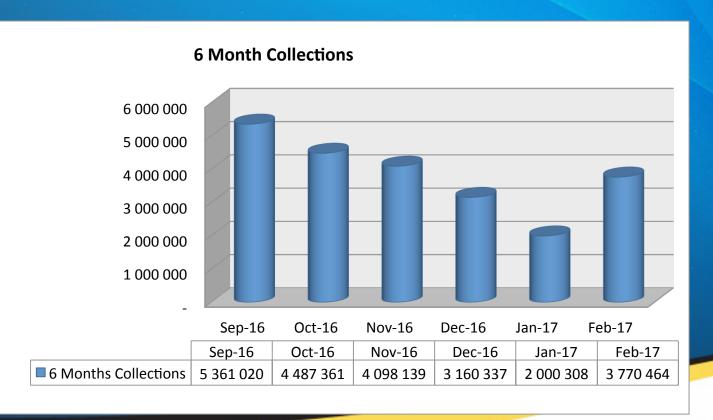

6 Months Collections (Graph)



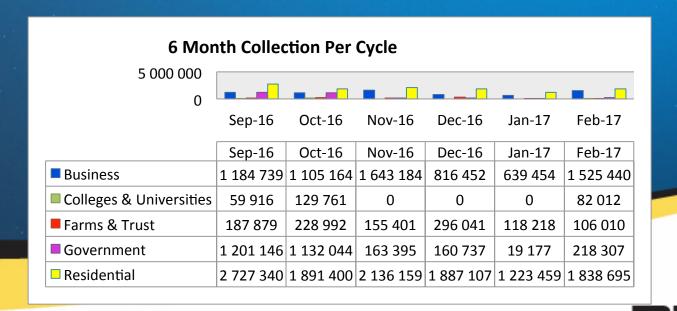

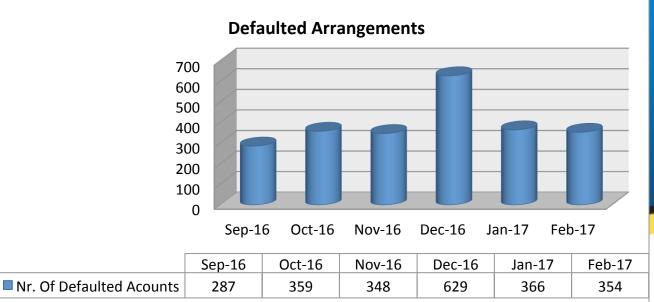

5. Focal areas

Core focus areas

- Key focus will be placed on Townships (limited credit control) special campaigns
 - Targeted campaign against pensioners- owned properties;
 - Targeted campaign against –confirmed employed;
 - CPA data- credit applications- potential source of income;
 - Property size and developments other than RDP structure- spatial analysis;
 - Incentive scheme to encourage a culture of payments within areas;
- Disconnection of electricity supply must be actioned against 771 deceased estates;
- Priority must be placed on performance managing the disconnection of electricity to defaulting households- achieved 72 out of 589 requested; 1 014 new requests in progress;
- BTO must as a matter of urgency effect write-down of all accounts deemed irrecoverable: specific focus must be on: Deceased estates, prescribed, indigents, liquidated etc- separate Request for closure submitted.
